What is financial counseling?

Financial Counseling is a private conversation between you and a Certified or Accredited Financial Counselor where you can discuss any of your financial concerns, goals, or just get your thoughts organized with someone who isn't emotionally involved in your situation.

What topics can I discuss in financial counseling?

You can discuss any personal finance topics with our counselors. The only thing we cannot do is give specific investing advice. Common topics we discuss with students include budgeting, student loans, credit cards, debt, retirement, building credit, purchasing a home, and basic tax questions.

How much does it cost?

Nothing. Your student fees pay for you to access financial counseling and we never charge for any of our office events.
